attention to my affairs

I think I shall venture
to pay the taxes on the Mason Co
lands. if I am wrong it will be
but the loss of about one or two hun-
dred Dollars and may save some
thousands to a perishing family

I send you with this the little
book on which I beg your opinion
and that of all who love me and
wish well to the dear object of my
fondest affections. My own College

I am here today & off for Casco
to morrow. Love to all who love
