10th Feb 1831.

My dear & venerated Friend

I lose not one day in apprizing you that
Lord Bexley has sent you another £100, and I enclose
his letter just received, to shew you that you owe some-

him I cannot conceive. May treat Lord B's letter confi-
dentially. If you received my last too late for deducting the
