## Letter to Mary Olivia Chase

Philander Chase

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New York 12<sup>th</sup> 1840 —

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My dear Mary, —

I am once more in this busy city and as busy myself as is possible to be and live.

Laura Chase your cousin is with me: and a very modest pretty girl she is. I know you will like her when on our way we call at Steubenville. This blessed event if God permit is now not far distant. In about one month or 6 weeks from this you may expect to receive. If you think that a long time, what shall I think of a year's absence from my dear family?

I preached last night and, tomorrow if I am able shall preach three times.

You see enough about me in the papers to render it quite proper for me to be silent on the subject of the College in Illinois. So reserving all private matters for a personal interview I am your loving grand father.
