Detroit 19th Aug 0th - 1880

My dearest Brother

You are constantly in my mind and in my prayers. May God bless and comfort you, and dear Olivea, my beloved sister through Jesus Christ our Lord.

You see by my date where I am. I preached twice yesterday for Wm. McCoskey who received me with great kindness.

I called on our dear Sister Sarah's son Rodney when passing the Little Falls below the City of Utica. He and his wife & children were well and enquired with much affection of all his Bethel & Randolph & Progate town friends. He gave me a set of bolting cloths for the Colley ^{Mill} worth \$50. besides 15. dollars in cash!!

What noble souls are those
in whose veins runs the blood
of your incomparable Father!

I had rather be the son or descendant
of Deacon Dudley Chase
than be of the regular dynasty
of the best family in Christendom.

I hope to get home in about
one week from this.

We set off in about 2 hours from
this in the Street Madisson for
Chicago.

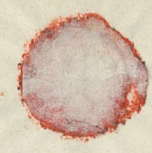
May God ever be with you
