Dear Sir

I enclosed I send you a
Cheque for £25. for Bishop Chan-
on J. George's acct. The sum due
to the good bishop is ^{the} 151. 86 which
I fancy will be about £30. In
this case what I send you
in addition to Mr. Harrison's
kind donation of £5 will meet
the call. At all events I am
not able to send a large
sum at present as my funds

are exhausted within a
few shillings which I have
in the Savings Bank. I hope
I fear, the next year will
find me still less prepared
I will do what I can. It
is possible that some other
kind friend may in the
interim be raised up as on
previous occasions to make
up what is wanting.

It is very gratifying

to find that the dear boy
in whom we have interested
ourselves appears to be
growing in grace as he
grows in years & that he
enjoys the esteem of
his revered father.
