Right Rev. & Dear Sir

I wrote to you about the  
 20<sup>th</sup> Jan, saying that I had instructed  
 my Bankers to forward to you £20 - of which  
 £9. 0. 8 was intended for Mrs George  
 & the remainder on S. George's acct. at  
 Jubilee - As it seems the arrival of  
 Letter, is not quite to be depended  
 upon I think it better to write a

a few lines to repeat my previous notification.  
As the facility of communication between  
England & America is increased I hope  
that our epistolary intercourse may be  
more frequent - To insure the delivery  
of our letters I think it will be better that  
we should neither of us prepay our letters.  
It seems also that Newspapers can  
be transmitted free of postage & I therefore  
purpose sending you occasionally  
a newspaper from England & at the  
same time I should be glad each

now and then to receive a Newspaper  
from Mennais & any little pamphlet  
which concerns your important  
Institution at Jubilee, as I may  
have it in my power to make it  
useful - That I may not miss  
the present post I must now  
conclude with assuring you that

I am right Rev. & dear Sir
