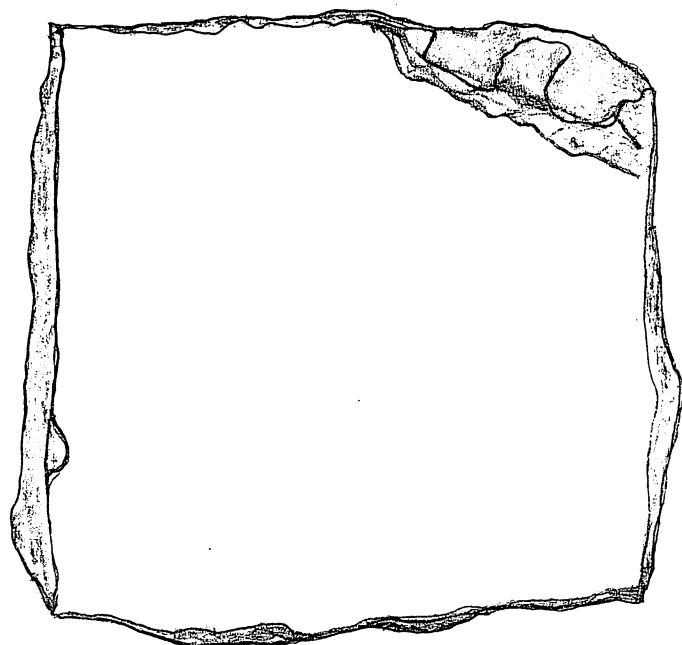

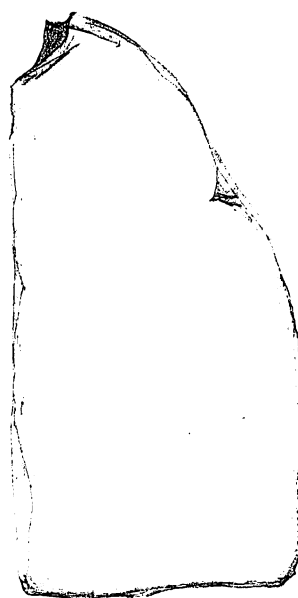
Verbal Description

Fragment of a metate. This is an edge piece of a metate, as may be seen by the curvature of the bottom. Most likely, a tiny bit of the lip has broken off where the top + bottom met. Top is worn very smooth from use. The other 3 sides have all been broken off. (No leg marks visible.)
