Verbal Description

Pierced ladle censer — rim piece with a partially preserved hole located on the wall of the piece. The approximate diameter of the hole is .4 cm and has been pierced from the interior. The ~~per~~ fragment is very eroded.

The firing core is med-dark gray and covers most of the fragment. There are no other signs of discolorations or alterations due to heat. The interior has been wiped and smoothed while the exterior, slightly darker in color, has also been wiped but is rougher than the interior. No slip, paint or decorations.
