

Raoul Wallenberg (1912-?)

A "Letter of Exemption" signed by Wallenberg. issued August 24.1944 designed to protect the daughter of a Hungarian art collector by identifying her as a Swedish subject. thereby exempting her from wearing the yellow star. and ultimately safeguarding her from deportation and murder in the Nazi death camps. Wallenberg. a Swedish diplomat saved thousands of Hungarian Jews from extermination during WW II.
