Burial. Exposed ~~femur~~ long bone before I started excavating, and it looks like there's more bones beneath it. Removing a root around the exposed longbone. There's already a piece of the longbone that the root has separated; its lying broken from the rest, but still clearly part of the bone. Even though the bone part is loose, I'll try to keep it in place.

Found another longbone (not a femur though, looks too small in comparison) heading into the side of the trench. Also found what looks like it may be the pelvic bone. Some bone is in good condition, while others are severely decomposed, making it hard. Finding / seeing sherds lying in, around, under, and on top of the bones.

Found a very small bit of carbon by a bone in the burial at about 90cm lgs. Was only a small fragment of Carbon.
