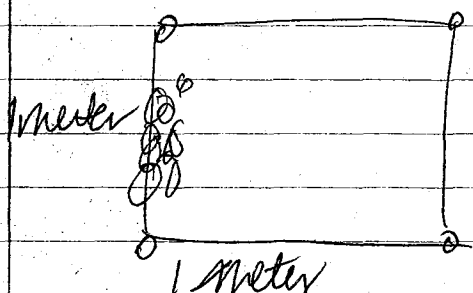

8:33 am - removed 2 rocks that had nothing under them + did not appear to have been in their original places + only rubble or tumble from somewhere else. But much more pottery, + larger pieces have been found.

9:00 am Pat + Ed looked @ some of the sherds + said that I almost have a whole incense vessel... it's only in pieces, + broken up, but all the pieces are probably from the same vessel.

8:28am Ed just came around + said it doesn't appear that there is any pattern w/ the rocks that are exposed now, but perhaps it could be the back of the wall but it's not all that apparent b/c there is a lot of other tumble + random rocks in the way that are confusing + messing up the layout of the wall structure.

8:45am Marvin just found a clay figure/pot type piece that has part of a little face. Very similar to one Angie found the other day. Soon I'll ~~be~~ start moving to the next square.

The southernmost square of my assigned squares, my last assign until before I come to the middle where Marcela is working up to.

9:30 am Working down in lot ¹¹ finding more pot sherds + larger sizes too. But less rocks as close to the surface as lot 10 in square #4. There are some rocks, but they're much further down.

10:43 am Still more pottery + even ^{some} ~~more~~ larger pieces. Ed came around + removed a lot of my rocks + revealed a little better my wall. The other rocks he removed are probably just tumble + don't belong there. He also told me I could start to excavate one of Marcela's squares so that I can get a better idea as to what is going on in my squares + suboperation.

11:35 pm Started digging + exposed more of the large pot. It's not intact + is broken but still just leaning it there. Also much more bajareque; almost everything found + bagged has been bajareque. Just waiting for Ed to come around + tell me what to do.

2:36 pm Removed the whole broken pot + put it in a separate bag. Also took some soil right ~~beneath~~ under broken parts for a float sample to determine if anything was in the pot such as seeds, etc. It appeared to have fallen + was crushed on top of itself. Also there were a lot of chert flakes + rocks near + in between the pieces of the broken pot. Also many pieces of obsidian have been recovered. - In general, there is a lot of "garbage" near the wall in lot 2. Many ruins of pots, but that one not always intact.

Sulfur

Sulfur is the Western interior Summit wall South of Cl. It runs the same as Argon, yet it is from a different construction period. My theory is that this wall was not here + constructed when Argon, Neon, Fluorine, + Phosphorous were built.

theory ① Sulfur was an opening or perhaps an entrance. Mainly due to the fact that Sulfur is only 1-2 courses deep + practically the bottom of Sulfur comes right about where Phosphorous probably ended. Sulfur + Cl appear as if they were constructed @ the same time b/c they share one rock that is sort of spanning both of them. They do not abutt each other.

theory ② Although another possibility is that the wall w/ the rock that could be in both is all Cl + then S just abutts Cl on the South + Argon abutts it on the North → they're 3 separate constructions or features

Phosphoropus is the Southern most inner summit wall.
(P) Just like Sulfur it's a very shallow wall w/ differing levels of courses, ranging from 1 to 4 @ several places along the wall. However, it was not constructed @ the same time as Sulfur b/c it is lower/deeper than Sulfur AND they abutt each other + are not interlined.

P is _____ cm long. For the most part it's just all large rocks + not many small chinking stones. It's not all that well preserved b/c it appears to be fall backwards or out + away from the summit or to the South. But then again so is Aluminum + Silicon, which are the back sides of P that make up the Southern basal wall. It all appears to be tilting to the South.

Potassium
(K) Is the first feature that was uncovered in the smaller flanking structure that is to the South of the main structure, Str. II.

It's a fairly nice + well preserved wall that's ~~ca~~ 2 courses deep. I believe it is the outer, basal ^{wall} of this smaller structure. ^{Southern} To the East it appears as if I found the corner, however after trying to follow the line as it turned North... there was nothing there... nothing in profile, so perhaps it wasn't the corner @ all. + the K continues out to the E... however, saw no ~~proof~~ evidence for that.

Yet, K does continue to the West, however it must turn + go South + then turn West again b/c Vanadium is the line that I found // to K yet, not on line. The problem is there's ~~nothing~~ in the way + the turn is probably somewhere under the steel.

Titanium Is a small line (possibly wall) that goes under K in the furthest place to the West that K is uncovered. It's a very thin line + also shallow, it could have been some type of platform or floor level.

Not very many interesting artifacts in this area @ all.

Ca is a thin + small line that is an outline for the interior of a room of some sort. From what's been uncovered it's approx. 2 courses + could possibly extend further to the North, yet it was only uncovered in one unit.

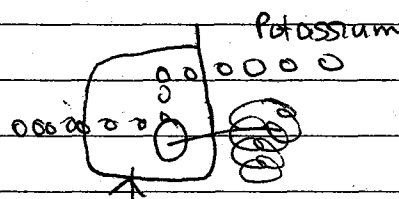
Interestingly though, Ca comes to the South + the turns to the West + turns into Scandium. The corner is strange b/c it's more of a curved + rounded corner + not a very 90° sharp angled corner like many of the others. Although it was a circular construction of a hearth or pit or something ~~even before~~ when I first saw it. But it's a corner that's very much so integrates both the walls together + they were constructed @ the same time.

Scandium is the other line that is connected w/ Ca. It runs along kind of poorly the further it's followed to the West, however, where it forms the interior line for the little room w/ Ca, it's nicely preserved. To the West closer to Chromium, it has just slipped + fallen + tumbled a little out of place.

Vanadium (V) Is a very small line that is // w/ K but is ~ 30 cm to the South of K, b/c I strongly believe, yet have to evidence to show that K turns somewhere under the tree + then turns again + that's the feature V;



This is only hypothesizing what is going on.

None of this is seen + is covered, mainly by the tree.

Chromium (Cr) Is the Western exterior basal wall connects + is ~~not~~ abutting w/ V to the South + extends up + connects w/ Manganese to the North. It's ~ 2-3 courses @ least from what's exposed + visible, perhaps it goes deep. It's fairly well preserved, except not too much on top. The top 2 courses have come off in some places, but it's still very distinguishable as being a wall.

Manganese Is essentially the corner + not very well preserved b/c only ~~50~~ ~ 50 cm of the wall was exposed, although I'd guess the wall is
