There are large rocks ~~about~~ starting about 5 cm under ground. The rocks are mostly on the side of the lot closest to the structure. Next lot will be 1 meter further away (North) from structure 58. We are also finding small stones that resemble chert, but are very red.

- Just started lot 3. got stung on my right index finger ~~for~~ by a bee that was in my bag. Killed it. Found usual sherds, some decorated. Found a 3 inch oval cherty stone that is very yellow in color. It was not like the surrounding rocks. Earth is still very dark in color. Found one piece of obsidian blade, very small.

- Starting lot 4 @ 30-40 cm. more of the same, hitting more tumble. Will remove it and go further down. Found marked piece of ceramic, much more obsidian. lots of ceramics, @ bottom, there is less tumble

about to start on lot 5. 40-50cm below ^{top} surface of lot 2. Still finding lots of sherds, but no chert or obsidian yet. Sherds are mostly slick colored, but some are beige. Found obsidian flake ~~and chert~~ and chert flake, forget what I wrote earlier. The walls have gotten rounded so I am ~~rounding~~ squaring out the corners - 'mas Recto'. lots and lots of sherds.

Lot 6 - 50-60cm. More sherds. More tumble on the ~~east~~ ^{east} side of lots 2-6. ~~found a piece of obsidian~~ one piece of obsidian which looks like a spear point. will go down 10 more cm.

Lot 7 - 60-70cm [abajo]-down. found mucho trestos. sherds all over the place. some larger flakes of obsidian. Blade = Gorda have found painted pottery and large pieces on west side of lot. Rediculous amount of pottery. This lot has taken the longest out of all the other lots to excavate. lots and lots of sherds. Pottery definitely gets cooler looking the further down ya go



Fragmentary, not much. Thought it was a
rotten root at first. This lot is taking forever.
Very large bag of sherds. Will start digging
under lot 1 next.

Starting lot 12, 50-60 cm. had no work yesterday (Monday) because of rain, even though it didn't ~~look like~~ really rain. I can't tell if it is a wall or just a lot of tumble on the south half of +13 lot ~~area~~ . So I am just excavating the north half which appears to be midden. Lots of large chunks of pottery.

Starting lot 13 60-70 cm. still finding lots of sherds. some nice large pieces with orange painted patterns on them. No obsidian. Am going to ~~not~~ go down one more to meet the level of lot 8. Am almost out of Bags & tags so I will have to go back to the house to pick them up in a little while.

Lot 14 70-80 cm. finding more sherds and some real thick ~~lumpy~~ baked clay which the workers are calling "barro" maybe it means brick. one half inch piece of obsidian, and a really thin ~~piece~~ blade. Not sure what to do next.

Lot 15. removing rocks under lot 14 to what may be a line. will go down 20 cm from 30-50 cm removing rocks from 40-70 cm ^{flat} across to possible line. Finding some ~~other~~ & a weird rock which seems to

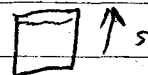
- Lot 20. 20-⁵⁰~~40~~ cm down. ~~20-40 cm down~~

and a few pieces of obsidian. Will clear square 7 next.



→ ~~Lot 29~~ Removed large rocks and dirt from squares 6, 7 and 8. Finding just the ~~common~~ stuff like gneiss and obsidian, so far +4.3 structure looks as a structure. No real defined walls. I hope I didn't tear them down by mistake. This is one of the southmost structures on the ~~SE~~ South western end of the site. It ~~is~~ is situated on a slope, which is probably runoff from the hill and the taller surrounding structures. It measures 4 feet off of current ground level at its center most point when looking left ^{"is 4"} S ~~N~~ .

Lot 29 10-20 cm ~~26'~~ below square 6 just removing dirt, mostly just rocks. Taking out rocks smaller than 4-5 inches. Will start @ South end of mound ~~next~~, after I clear out under square 7 and 8.

→ Lot 30 10-20 cm below square 7. Same as before. Not much. Just removing dirt and small rocks.

→ ~~Lot 31~~ Lot 31 broken pottery in one spot next to a red rock. Will go to South end of structure next. This is boring. These past 3 lots have taken 4 hours. Bla.

There seems to be a wall on the north end of lot 30 and one on the north end of lot 31. (Flat sides of rocks facing South) starting South most lot next

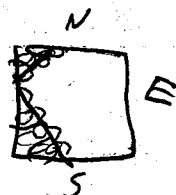

Look up hermanos ^{=Bro's} - I think I might have told Santos I have 5 brothers. Well, I did. oops.

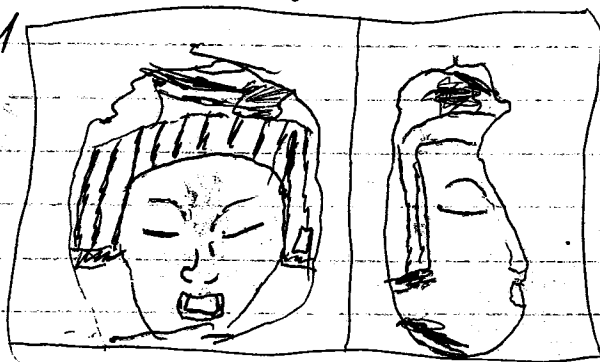

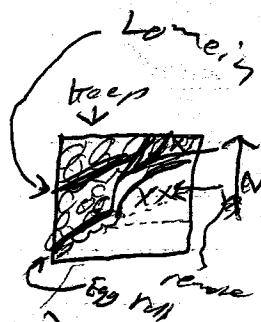

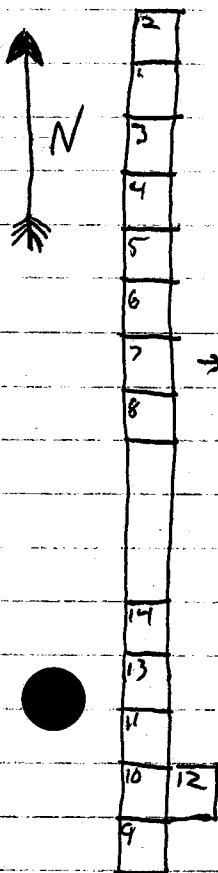

It looks like Lomein and the ~~the~~ possible back side of Lomein are propped up against this possible wall. We'll see.

→ Lot 47 ^{20-40 cm below ground surface of square 13} removing ~~rocks~~ surface rock on a possible wall to see if one exists. Situated between Squares 11 and 13. Will excavate from the square 13 to see if wall really exists, and then move on to square 14. Emilio made a little free out of the ~~soft~~ soft wet limestones and stuck it back into the SE corner. Mostly slendys, can't tell about the wall yet, so I will go 10 deeper.

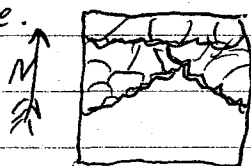

Bunch of steds in this area, ~~appear~~ floor appears to be built on midden, which probably means floor was added on after wall was built because there are usually a lot of steds next to walls, but there ~~wasn't~~ wasn't too many on the floor. Found ~~a~~ a large chunk or cache of barro/bajareque under this entire area. looks like a floor that may go under the wall and rock floor. It doesn't seem to go under the wall, ~~but it's~~ because there are deeper rocks, but it is definitely a Bajareque floor.

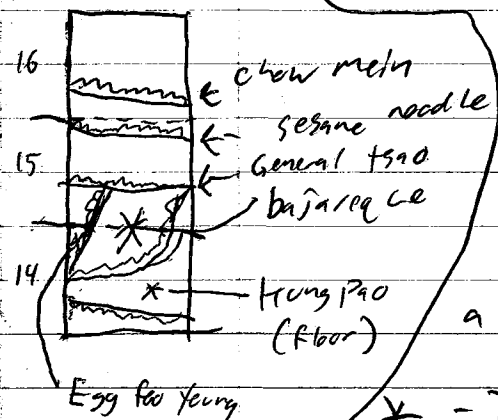

→ lot 63. 10-30 cm below ground surface of Square 16 of a Xial trench. removing tumble, trying to find wall. It looks like there are a few lines. I named the lower one Sesame Noodle, and the higher one Chow mein. These are all on top of the larger wall General Tsao. The floor's name is Hung Pao, and the possible wall intersecting General Tsao at a right angle is Egg Foo Young.



* - The bajareque floor is roughly 10 cm. directly beneath floor named Hung Pao. which is 40 cm below ground surface on the ~~the~~ lowest slope of the Western side. It forms a lip and stops at wall named General Tsao, but does go under possible wall named Egg Foo Young. This means Egg Foo Young is ~~older than~~ younger than the bajareque and General Tsao, and the bajareque is ~~older~~ younger than General Tsao.

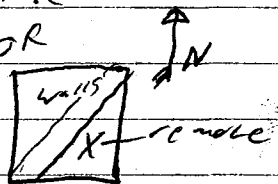

→ lot 73. 0-20 cm below ground surface of square 25. Directly East of square 3 on North side of mound, following wall named - Wonton - East. ~~Obsidian~~ [shells and obsidian]

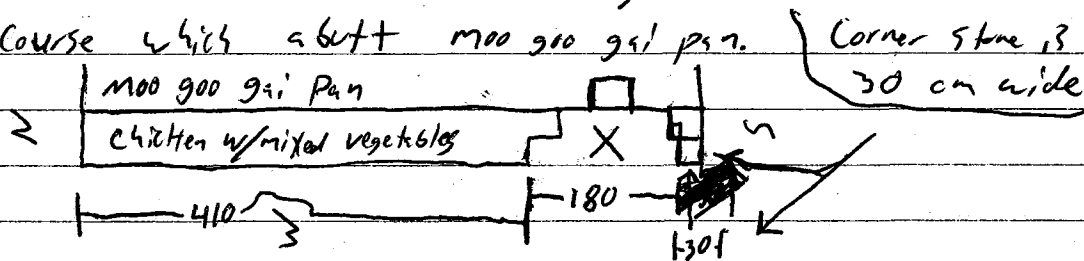
Rough drawing of Structure 58 completely excavated

Structure 58 had several phases of construction. Shards found under main inside walls of room 3, and a large rock about 5 cm below NE corner of room 3 may indicate that structure 58 was built on top of a much earlier structure. (chicken with mixed vegetables), (General Tso), and (Port fried rice) are not ~~integrated~~ integrated into the main base platform, which means these, and possibly everything south of (General Tso) was a later addition. Since (Spring roll) runs East behind (chow fun) all the way through to (Garlic chicken), and (Ramen) also abuts (Spring roll), this shows that everything including room 1 and 2, ~~was~~ was built after the construction of (Spring roll) AKA (Cris rangoon). (Spring roll) corners with (Happy Family), which may mean that everything west of (Happy Family) was a later addition also. There may have been a patio north of (Spring roll). There are no entrance ways into the main room of structure 58 (room 3), that we can tell. It is possible that (Garlic chicken) was a later addition, and (Niche 2) was possibly the main ~~entrance~~ entrance into room 3 through (Eastern wall). (Shredded pork) and (Soy Sauce) were built on top of the floor in room 3, and abuts (Cris rangoon), (Happy Family), and (Subgum), which means ~~that~~ (shredded pork) and (Soy Sauce) were constructed after the completion of room 3. These walls appear to have been placed to turn room 3 into a storage room. I believe, in its final phase of complete construction, structure 58 was used for storage or manufacturing, not for living residence.

Trench 219 A-B appears to have been placed between structures 2 + 3 on the site map. 2 platforms were uncovered possibly linking the 2 structures together.

These platforms are separated by 60 cm. The largest Northern-most one stretches 335 cm N→S, with (Arby's) being the Northern wall, and Wendy's being the Southern wall.

The smaller Southern one is 265 cm long, with a Northern basal line named (Rally's), and then a defined Northern platform line set 10 cm south of (Rally's) named (Burger King).

Site 219 is located on a flat plane next to the high way across from the Lear Automotive ~~for~~ factory. ~~AP~~ This site consists of 8+ structures, some couples connected to one another. All construction appears to be of the ugly post-classic kind, made of a few cobbles, but mostly unrounded chunks of stone. There were some cut stones used in summit features which may have been borrowed from another site. ~~Some of these~~ This was a salvage dig due to the fact that a factory is ~~planned~~ planned to be built on this site. We have only had a week to work on it, and have laid 4 Axial trenches over the main structures, and a few other smaller trenches to find corners and other features. The majority of the site is left unexcavated. Along with the normal amount of ugly sherds usually found, we have found nicely painted pottery, obsidian cores, stamps, figurine heads, and bits of Altareñas. There was one whole rim piece found in pit 219 M, and the majority of one in the summit room of 219 I-H.

219 I-H was an axial trench over structure 6. This structure was roughly 520 cm N-S, but it isn't exact due to the lack of a definite southern wall. It was also approximately 1130 cm E-W, but no definite western wall could be found.
