VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Section of a multi-chamber ocarina. Two half-chambers and their connecting channel preserved and part of the flute-type mouthpiece. ~~Channel pierced from mouth piece chamber to 2<sup>nd</sup> chamber. (at least) 3<sup>rd</sup> chamber.~~ Chambers are 2.86 and 2.71 cm.

Channel = 0.87 cm. Moderately eroded, but bottom broke in part on cut lines. Clay envelope thin; can see where clay for mouth piece was applied. No firing core, burning, slip, paint or decoration. Exterior smooth, with part of a scar, probably from check or other applique. Not drawn.
