VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Solid anthropomorphic facial fragment from a large figure. The fragment includes the central 1/3 of the face with a large, unbroken triangular nose (2.29 wide, 2.28 long, juts out from face 2.27~), raised & margin, slit eyes w/ pupils punctated completely through the face to the interior. The lids are slightly raised & there is a thin, raised brow over each eye. The entire surface is smooth but slightly webbed. Inter-glazed by color, no paint or slip.
