figurine. Three grooves separate the 4 fingers; the
grooves were enhanced by a tool. A larger groove
separates the thumb from the fingers. Thumb is
exaggeratedly large, and has nail delimited by a line.
Fingers are square on ends, as though trimmed, and
have no nails. Hand may be holding a vessel. No
slip, paint. Not drawn. Interior irregular and
eroded; edges moderately eroded.
