VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Moderately to very eroded figurine fragment with left side of head/neck. The punctated sphere ear flare is very thick/deep on outer/neck edge. Hole in center is large for such an ear flare: hole = 0.41 cm; Flare = 1.10 cm. above this is the brim and projecting point of a Napolean-style headdress. The brim has one vertical line just directly above the ear flare. Neck is very short: 2.75 cm from back bottom to shoulder. Join sharp at back where neck is. Back convex. Interior shows several clay layers and multiple finger marks. No burning, firing cone, paint, slip. Not drawn.
