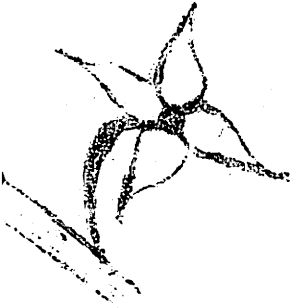

VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Fragment of a hollow, anthropomorphic figurine with the proper right ear + earflare. The flare is a punctated sphere 0.92 cm in diameter. The sphere is rounded on the exterior margin + slightly squared on the interior. The ear above it is formed by a raised curl. The back is convex, the interior is smooth but not well-finished. Interior: shifted firing core. There are slight traces of orange slip (7.5R 5/8) on the rear surface. mold-made. No incision.
