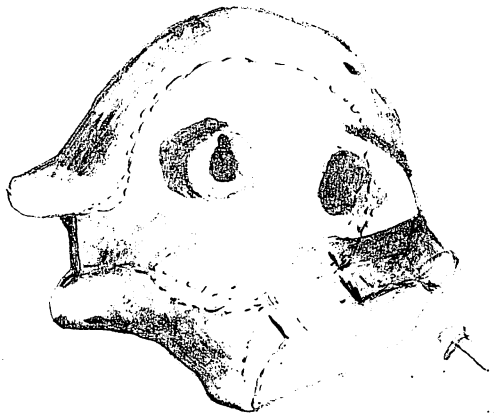

VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Ocarina fragment. Zoomorphic, with a dog or deer's head. The head has two turned-back ears. Laurel-leaf shaped, two punctated-sphere eyes, a flute-shaped mouth for the mouth of the animal. The top of the head is round & smooth. The instrument includes a Channel (1.04) connecting the chamber inside the head which is connected to a chamber in the torso. The head is upturned wrt the body. No paint, slip, or fig design.
