Solid fragment of a headless figure of a  
serpent head in profile of a human head emerges  
from it. The serpent includes a curved, raised margin  
above of a recessed central field above an  
almost-shaped eye with a protruded pupil. The nose  
is rounded. The face is also in profile & the  
eyes are almost-shaped w/ raised margins. The mouth is oval  
w/ raised margins & a rectangular tooth. The figure is solid w/  
a flat back & an attached base along the serpent's lower part.
