Fragment of a hollow, anthropomorphic figure with the upper portion of the left arm - very curved, a small, pointed breast and a collar composed of rectangular beads strung on a thin cord. The interior is smooth, there is an interior firing core, the head does not appear to have opened into the body. Conus surface. No paint or slip.
