VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Large fragment of a multi-chambered occarina. This is one of the quadruped versions with fragments of 3 Chambers, 2 Channels, and one Stop. There is a double pediment (2 raised, appressed spheres) suspended from an appressed cord and the chert. There are 2 Correl Feet attached to the lower, front Chamber. There are a number of clay cracks, but the chamber interior thickness are smooth. The stop has a flattened area about it.

Stops 0.85cm

Correl Support length 1.52cm

Channels: 0.98cm + 1.1cm

Pediment: 1.51cm + 1.81cm

Being on the exterior, no fig core.
