body. The head is round & pinched w/ unevenly
mounted punctated sphere eyes on either side of the
head, a triangular beak w/ an unpunctated bill bump
to a suspension hole drilled through the neck. Light
stucco/white deposit on exterior surface as part
or shell. Light inter-glazed by cover.
