VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Solid fragment of a hollow anthropomorphic  
figurine with the left portion of the face  
& headless present. The headless includes a  
smooth upper bonnet with a raised band  
0.8cm wide with punctated spheres along it.  
The ear includes a punctated sphere earflange  
with a curved rim portion above it. The  
eye is almond-shaped & has a grooved brow  
above it. The inner surface is fairly smooth  
with finger marks. The back is slightly convex.  
No paint, slip, or glaze, but the exterior  
surface is highly burnt.
