Solid figure of the proper right side of a hollow anthropomorphic figure. The figure includes a ground triangular flange headless with a large protruded sphere below the flange beneath the end of the flange. The entire side is slightly flattened. The neck is recessed. The shoulder is very wide & curved. The top of a cuff/wristlet is present - it is found by a raised band. The back is convex & fine closed. The entire surface is rough & has a seam along the front/back break. No feet or slip.
