VERBAL DESCRIPTION: Piece of a hollow figurine showing a hand (right) holding a vessel. The hand has 4 fingers and thumb, all the same size, very rectangular and blunt. The fingers are defined by grooves, and the end of the hand by a vertical line. The nails are small dots, indented. The vessel has a straight wall and an outflared rim. The wall at the base has 2 raised bands of rectangles, 6 per band. These are very poorly defined. Band is 0.8 cm wide x 0.10 cm high. The mid wall has 4 short, vertical incisions; these look added, not molded. On top are 4 raised, round objects surrounding a 5th in a petal-like arrangement. The top of each has a small, indistinct, round impression/dot. These 5 objects are poorly defined, and look molded, not applied. Back of hand is burnished, and there are traces of blue on the vessel and its contents. Not drawn; saved for photo. No firing core -- vessel is not solid.
