VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Solid edge fragment of a hollow, anthropomorphic
figure of a Sunburst headdress. The proper left
side of the figure is painted & the headdress has
3 slightly convex, horizontally grooved projections
which are graduated in size (largest on top).
The projections are bordered by a series of 2 grooves &
a raised, fluted area. The back is convex. The
entire figure is lightly covered in stucco. No paint
on slip. Smooth on the surface with a few figure
impressions. No fingering.
