VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Solid head fragment from a hollow figurine. The figurine includes a crudely rendered face with slit eyes with pinched pupils, a slit mouth - pinched in the center - & a broken, triangular nose. The ears are pinched with slightly raised margins. The top of the head includes a shock of hair which stands straight up - (defined by grooves) around a smooth, wide horizontal groove. The back is flat, the sides open into a smooth, rounded chape. There is light pink slip on the eyes.
