VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Vessel. Held in the program the head. The vessel includes a plain, flat top with a groove setting this area off from the main parts of the body. The central part includes a raised area with diagonal grooves (5). The base is a raised area w/ a beveled groove. The base is also smooth & flat (like the top). The head is well-formed & includes a shorter flange (which rests along the upper right hand) lies above the 4 rectangular fingers defined by 3 grooves. The wrist off includes 3 vertical lines of 4 protruding fingers defined by grooves. 1st & 2nd finger low, smooth with surface. This of the organ shape (VOR 7/8) in the head's creases.
