This is an unclear piece: it is either
the junction between 2 hollow parts of a large

Very eroded. Upper (?) exterior has 2 round

has 2 very low relief (0.07cm) U-like elements.
Could also be a crumbly miniature cylinder
vessel with a wing base. Who knows? Not
drawn. Abs slip, paint, firing core.
