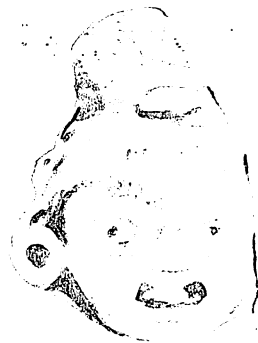

VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Facial fragment of a human figure w/ a head band w/ 2 punctated spheres on the proper rt. end & a tied knot of hair above the band (buckle form). The face has almond-shaped eyes w/ punctated pupils, a triangular nose, a trapezoidal mouth w/ 3 rectangular teeth & a rounded chin - finished underneath. This is probably a single-chamber ocarina w/ a flute mouthpiece behind the knot of hair. Smooth rounded interior surface. Centered by cone. No post or stop.
