## Description:

This site is located south of the Quebrada Aguacate + east of the main Sta. B./Taulaké highway. It is also directly east of Site 302. It lies on a series of low, undulating terraces.

The structures are all low + small (housemounds?). These structures are defined by walls composed of a single course of cobbles. Many of these cobbles did not come from the adjacent quebrada, but are more angular stones that litter this entire area.

Many structures have elevation only on their west face.
