PROVENIENCE. Structure 18. Unit 20 ^{is its SW corner} located 2.95 m north of the SE corner of unit 3, the west side wall of unit 20 is 1 m east of the west side wall of the axial trench (thus the east side wall of unit 20 is approx. 3.15 m east of the west side wall of the axial trench due to the dimensions of unit 20) and it is north of units 14, 15 and 16. The dimensions of the unit are: Northern = 2.13 m; southern = 2.20 m; eastern = 1.13 m; western = .7 m; the unit is a blocky, backwards L-shape. lot 96 is the removal of ^{5cm} ~~10cm~~ in order to locate the continuation of the east-west Rwanda suture in unit 19.

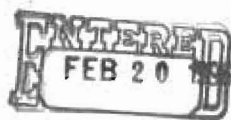
