PROVENIENCE. Structure 18 unit 20 has its SW corner located 2.95 m north of the SE corner of unit 3, the west side of unit 20 is 1 m east of the west sidewall of the apical trench and A is north of units 14, 15 and 16. The dimensions of the unit are: northern = 2.13 m, southern = 2.20 m, eastern = 1.13 m and western = .7 m. Lot 99 is an excavation space 80 cm long (E-W) by 50 cm wide (N-S) to 40 cm below ground level. This area begins immediately west of lot 98 and south of the Rumanian feature.

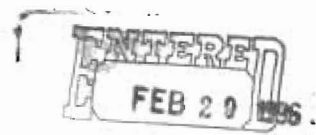
