Fragment from the central portion of a candelario. The paste interior is badly burned, so it is impossible to detect the presence or absence of a fire core. The exterior surfaces, which appear to have comprised the flutes, have also been burned. Hardness = 1.7 cm. The surface is very rough and jagged on the fluted areas and considerably smoother on the flat, end surface. There is a lot of visible temper. The flutes appear to range from .9 cm to .4 cm in diameter and extend the entire length of the fragment. There is no paint, slip, applique or modeling, and the flutes appear to have been formed by a probing, cylindrical object. There are no handle scars.
