paste int: 10YR 6/3

Fragment of a red. censer which includes a portion of the rim. There is a fire core 3 cm wide which extends to within .2 cm of the vessel walls. Neither the wall thickness nor the fire core are uniform throughout the sherd. There is also evidence of burning on the exterior surface. The surfaces are quite worn and rough. The exterior surface has a number of grooves and abrasions which run vertically along the body, while there appear to have been brush strokes curving around the rim. The interior surface has brush strokes which run horizontally. The upper 2.5 cm of the rim are slightly everted. The lip has been flattened as well. There is also a notch cut into the wall of the fragment. There are clay scraps within the corner, so it may have been cut hastily and carelessly. It extends 1.5 cm horizontally and on a vertical diagonal for 2.9 cm. The notch's walls are 1 cm thick. There is no slip, paint, or applique.
