Fragment of a hollow figurine. There is no fire core, but fire cladding is present and extends 1.5cm along the wall of the fragment and .9cm towards the interior. There is no other surface burning. Hardness 2-7. There is a solid protrusion, which is quite rounded and smooth which extends along the length of the fragment. Below it, the surface flattens out and becomes smoother. The interior surface is much rougher. There is no slip or paint.
