Fragment of a hollow figurine. Hardness 5-2. There is a fire core 2cm wide which extends to within 1mm of the fragment's walls. There is no burning or fire dividing. The surface is smooth although there is a lot of visible temper. The fragment may be a portion of a figurine foot. There is a groove along the bottom of the fragment .4cm wide and three vertical incisions along the front which divides the fragment into three rectangular blocks. This could also represent belts on a belt, or other clothing elements. The rectangles extend 1.2cm from the body of the fragment and were probably applied. There is no paint or slip.
