VEREAL DESCRIPTION:

Frag of a hollow, mold-made, anthropomorphic figurine with part of a headdress topped by a frog leg or part of a feathered collar with a frog leg suspended below it. Curved head to 3 rows of horizontal incisions + 19 rows of vertical incisions. There are also applied, punctated puffy doughnut spheres. Frog leg enters through lower leg and raised flippers. Fragment is concave no frog core, cloudy, burning part on slip.
