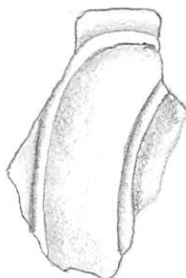

VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Fragment of a figurine, which, from the portion available, may have been solid. Hardness 1.7. Color: paste int: *10R 6/8* paste ext: *5YR 4/6*. The surface varies - The front, which has been decorated, is quite smooth, while the back is rough. The design on the front of the fragment appears to have been formed by incision - drawing a circle around a smoothed area, and then building up the surrounding areas. There is not enough of the design preserved to definitively identify it. There is no slip, paint, or applique.



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
