VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Fragment of a hollow figurine. There is no fire core, fire clouding, or surface burning. Hardness: 1,2. Color: paste int: 2.5YR 5.5/8 paste ext: 10YR 6/8. The surface is very smooth on the side with the designs and rougher on the back of the figurine. The design is reminiscent of the crimping on a turnover, but is probably a portion of a headress or decorative clothing. The design appears to have been formed by incising the vertical back marks and the horizontal groove (.2 cm wide; less than 1mm deep). The vertical marks may have been made on an applique strip of clay, slightly rectangular in shape, but it is difficult to be sure. There is no paint or slip. The entire fragment is concave, and the back of the figurine forms a 60° angle with the front.
