Fragment of a hollow figurine which was probably mold made. Hardness: 1.5  
 There is no fire core or surface burning. There is a small amount of fire clouding along the brim of the headress (2.4 cm long, 1.4 cm high). The interior surface is rough and shows no evidence of having been smoothed while portions of the exterior, especially the back of the figurine, are quite smooth. The design elements include a headress 3 cm wide, 2-3 cm high which has a rectangular section containing an applique "X" which resembles the elements found in Maya day glyphs and as a portion of the symbol for the mat. There is a vertical groove which sets this rectangle off from the remainder of the headress. The rectangle created by this groove is bifurcated by a horizontal groove into 2 smaller rectangles. These grooves are 2 mm wide and less than a mm deep. This entire portion is connected to the head of the figurine by an incised headress brim which ends in a flanged section. All that remains of the face is an applique earspool (1.1 cm in diameter). The spool is separated from the remainder of the fragment by incisions which curve along its margins, as well as diagonally below it, separating the face from the neck. There is also a portion of the left shoulder present.  
 There is no slip or paint. The back of the headress is flat, and the back of the head curves away from the front.
