VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Hollow-mold-made big frog with a heavily burnished, very smooth convex back. The front has a vertically raised, burnished triangular headless flange with wavy smoothing marks along the top. There is a punctated, puffy cap-like and the shoulder curves up near the flange. No fine cone-paint, or slip, but there is a dark brown blotch on the burnished back.
