Fragment of a hollow figurine. There is no fire core ^{and} ~~only~~ ^{slight} evidence of fine clouding. Hardness 1.3 The surface is smooth, with the exterior surface being smoother than the interior which ~~does~~ not seem to have been intentionally smoothed as the exterior does. The figurine seems to represent the right side of a seated figure - including the right knee and the right elbow, ~~shoulder~~ and forearm. A right earpool may also be represented. All of the surfaces have been rounded and smoothed on the exterior of the fragment, but the interior has a few impressed or brushed-in lines. Directly above what may be the right hand with a flattened surface ~~on~~ top of it or clutched in it on the interior surface there are two gauge marks that may have been made while the clay was still wet (they are very smooth and rounded). On the exterior, above the earpool, there may have also been a hat or headdress. The back of the figurine curves away from the front, smoothly, and the earpool and arm appear to have been applied. There is no slip or paint.
