Fragment of an ocarina tunnel and surrounding matrix. There is no fire core, fire clouding, or surface burning. Hardness: 1.7. The surface is worn and weeds have grown onto the inner surface, damaging the paste. The fragment contains the end of the tunnel which opened into the sounding chamber. This end of the tunnel which opens into the sounding chamber is surrounded by scraps of clay, and the tunnel has been formed quite carefully. On the exterior surface, there is a slight dip between the interior break and the exterior break. There is no paint, slip, or applique.
