Fragment of an elongated-u censer handle which contains a small portion of the cross-piece. Hardness = 1.7. There is a fire core 3 cm wide which extends to within .2 cm of the handle walls. In the cross-piece, the fire core extends to within .4 cm of the walls and has a diameter of 1.3 cm. There is no burning or fire charring. The surface is very eroded, there are number of abrasions along the flat side, a faint mat impression below the cross-piece scar, and a number of paste inclusions are visible. The cross-piece is rough and uneven in form. The margins are very slightly flattered. There is no paint, slip, or incision.
