Fragment of an elongated-V censer handle which includes the curved portion of the handle. Hardness 3.2. There is a fine core. It is .6 cm wide and comes to within .2 cm of the handle's wall on the lower portion of the handle and is .4 cm wide and comes to within .15 cm of the handle wall in the break of the upper portion. There is no evidence of fire cladding or burning. There are no handle scars present (the breaks are clean and jagged). The surface is worn and there are a number of abrasions and nicks on the exterior-facing surfaces of the handle - some of them quite deep. On the interior-facing surface there are four distinct, evenly spaced hash marks which run diagonally in relation to the broken edge. They range from 1.4-1.6 cm in length and appear to have been formed by impression or incision. On the interior-facing side of the upper-portion there are impressions or incisions which form a criss-cross pattern - diagonally oriented which extends 2.5 cm from the break. There is no paint, slips or applique.
