Full Verbal Description: A fragment of a long bone from a large (or possibly medium-large) mammal. It is a thick-walled bone, maximally 0.42 cm. There is a groove (width 0.1 cm, depth 0.03 cm) paralleling its length which I see as natural. On the interior, opposite the groove, is a small raised area of the same size and orientation. The surface is otherwise marked by tiny pits. I believe it to have been used because one edge, broken at a steep angle, is ^{much} smoother than the other edges and appears to have been abraded. Not drawn.
