The new block measures 1 meter x 1 meter, 3 meters from the N.W. end of a trench crossing structure #3 in a N.W. - S.E. fashion. The trench is 17.65 m x 1 m, and Lot #15 will be excavated at a depth of 0-20 cm from the datum pt. on the northernmost stake in Block #3
