PROVENIENCE. 30cm from N.W. end of block #4. Was excavated down to a depth of as low as 50cm, in order to remove rubble. Is a meter wide. The datum point was marked on the northernmost stake. This lot contains construction "Apr", which begins 40cm from the N.W. end of the block and ends 50cm from the floor.
