PROVENIENCE. At a depth 40cm (measured from northernmost stake on Block #5) Lot 21 is the first screen, beginning 15cm in from the N.W. end of Block #5. It's one meter wide. Block 5 begins 4 meters from the N.W. end of a trench crossing str. #3 at a N.W.S.E. fashion with a length of 15.65m and width of 1m.
